In line with the SGI theme of “Year of Developing a Youthful SGI”, we would like to ask each men's division leader to raise a successor. As leaders, let's create a corps of capable men who share our mentor's heart for *kosen-rufu*, starting with us taking full responsibility to inspire and raise one men's division in our district. With this same spirit, let's continue to empower and support the young men to develop their corps of youthful disciples.

In 2012, let's:

- 1) Continue to hold weekly chanting sessions together with the young men's division. We would like to encourage studying “To My Dear Friends in America,” especially President Ikeda's addresses given in 1990. The organizations carrying out these weekly chanting and study sessions have shown clear result in the personal growth of the men and in the membership.
- 2) Unite with the women, young men and women to create and participate in meaningful and joyful discussion meetings while empowering the youth to take the lead.
- 3) Advance our study movement by promoting and participating in the monthly study meetings and annual study exam.
- 4) Hold general meetings in August jointly with the young men and focus on increasing the young men's participation. To make this happen, let's ensure that the young men take equal responsibility in planning the meeting.
- 5) Promote the three FNCC men's division conferences with a special focus on inviting men who have recently graduated from the young men's division and those who have not yet been to a men's division conference. (Conference dates are as follows: Men's#1 August 17-20, Men's#2 October 12-15, and Men's#3 December 7-10)
