FNCC

The Florida Nature and Culture Center (FNCC), has installed an audio loop system for people with hearing loss in the Friendship Auditorium. Its presence is marked by a small blue T-coil logo that signals to hearing aid wearers to switch to the T-coil. Anyone with a T-coil, that is, a small copper wire that’s an option on most hearing aids and built into cochlear implants, can connect to the system.
