To build a solid infrastructure to support our growing membership, it is clear that the establishment of Groups and Group leaders are essential to our kosen-rufu movement in America. Therefore, SGI-USA is excited to announce that from today, September 30, district and chapter data entry users are now able to strategically create and manage Groups via the SGI-USA online statistics system.

ENHANCEMENTS

Group Names

Data entry users can now officially name their Groups.

Group Management

Once Groups have been established, data entry users can strategically place members into their Groups.

Group Meeting Attendance

When in-person discussion meetings resume, data entry users will be able to report attendance at the Group level.

Reporting Attendance

Data entry users will be able to provide key statistics and subscriptions reports to their Group leaders, such as a Group Membership List.
